The company operates a zero-tolerance approach to modern slavery, and we are committed to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business dealings.

The company acknowledges responsibility to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and will ensure transparency within the organisation. We expect the same high standards from all our contractors, suppliers and other business partners.

As part of the company's due diligence process into slavery and human trafficking the company will not support or deal with any business knowingly involved in slavery or human trafficking.

Millennium Personnel Services Ltd is a recruitment agency supplying personnel across the UK and EU. This policy applies to all persons working for MPS Ltd or on behalf of Millennium Personnel Services Ltd in any capacity, including employees at all levels, directors, officers, agency workers, seconded workers, volunteers, inters, agents, contractors, external consultants, third-party representatives and business partners.

The company directors and senior management shall take responsibility for implementing this policy statement and its objectives and shall provide adequate resources (training, etc.) to ensure that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place within the organisation.

Employees are expected and encouraged to formally document any concerns regarding modern slavery and trafficking to management, where they will be acted upon. GLAA & police will be informed of any concerns.
